Install & Connect Modules

The concept of pre-plumbed modules is not new, but the way that it is achieved by Tenon Washrooms is revolutionary. Traditional pre-plumbed methods have a number of associated drawbacks such as accessing a site with heavy, cumbersome and often fragile units; sanitaryware that is exposed to damage in transit; and exposure to other trades on site as panels are removed to complete the installation and plumbing.

Tenon IPS re-defines the standard for easy to specify, simple to install pre-plumbed systems by a number of ingenious design features and attention to detail.

Robust, self supporting modules

Tenon IPS is a self supporting module manufactured from strong 16 gauge galvanised steel – not just a flimsy frame. It is fully adjustable for height, plumb and level, effectively creating a pre-plumbed duct wall.

Complete and ready to install

The modules are produced to specification, including plumbing, sanitaryware, water & soil connections and then function tested. Decorative access panels are fitted already machined, ready to receive sanitaryware.

Protective packaging

Each module is tested, numbered and vulnerable sanitaryware removed and boxed for protection. All decorative access panels are removed, numbered and packed to prevent damage.

Easy to handle on site

On site, the modules are lightweight and easy to handle, ideal for transfer into often limited size washroom facilities. Vulnerable parts and sanitaryware remain protected until required, eliminating the risk of damage.

Easy 5 step installation

Installation of Tenon IPS modules is achieved in five easy stages, which delivers a rapid and efficient completion to the project. Sanitaryware is repositioned and fixed, water and soil services coupled up and decorative access panels refitted to complete the installation.

Stage 1

Using the site preparation drawings provided by Tenon, the plumber installs first fix water supply using flexible, isolating pipework, plus the soil pipework. Any other concealed services are also fitted at this stage. The washroom installer fixes IPS floor and wall tracks into position.

Stage 2

The IPS frames, with cisterns pre-fitted where appropriate, are located into the floor and wall tracks by the washroom installer, centred on the soil pipework. Frames are adjusted for height, plumb and level then securely fixed to tracks.

Stage 3

Decorative frame infill spacer panels, skirting and ceiling scribes are fitted into place.

Stage 4

The lower decorative access panels and sanitaryware are refitted by the washroom installer and coupled to the water supply and soil pipework. The plumber tests the system for leaks and completes any service work.

Stage 5

The installation fully tested, the washroom installer fits the remainder of the decorative access panels and applies silicon joint sealant where necessary. Cubicles can now be fixed into position as required.
